


NOTICE OF MEETING

8. Engineering matters, including preparation and approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, pay estimates and change orders, acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facilities.
9. Discuss wastewater treatment plant lease buy out and authorize appropriate action.
10. Acceptances of easements/deeds.
11. Sterling Lakes Property Owners Association's matters.
12. Receive report on development in the District.
13. Update on bond election.
14. Next meeting date.
